RODEO DETAILS: In addition to the indoor and outdoor exhibits and information sessions, municipal members are invited to participate in an Equipment Rodeo.

TEAMS: Municipalities may field a maximum of two teams. Teams must have three members. For those municipalities who do not have three operators, you may combine with another municipality to form a team or request that the Trade Show Committee supplies members to form a team.

EVENTS AND EQUIPMENT: There will be seven skill events which may include equipment such as a backhoe, truck (automatic transmission, CDL not required), mini-backhoe, lawn tractor, skid steer loader, obstacle course. On the day of the show, team members select three of the seven events in which to participate. Events will be timed and/or judged and will include general operation and/or implement specific skills.

PRIZES: Cash \$\$\$ prizes will be awarded for first, second and third places in each event and trophies will be presented for overall team championship.

REGISTRATION: Please pre-register your team using the form below. If you list less than three members, the Trade Show Committee will assign members to form a team. All Rodeo participants will receive a BCPWA t-shirt. Please indicate size below.

VOLUNTEERS: We need non-rodeo participants to help judge the rodeo events. Volunteer judges will receive a free BCPWA t-shirt. Please put a "V" next to your name below if you are interested.
